The Optimist International Junior Golf Championships is one of the largest and best-known junior golf tournaments in the world. Each year, more than 600 golfers participate in THE OPTIMIST. Optimists have been involved in the sport of junior golf for more than 30 years by holding local, regional and international tournaments. More than 5,000 golfers compete in official Optimist District qualifying tournaments. The best of these golfers, along with international golfers from around the globe, advance to the annual Optimist International Junior Golf Championships. All U.S. players ages 10-18 must qualify through a District Qualifying Tournament and be sponsored be sponsored by an Optimist Club. The Capital Virginia District qualifying tournament will be held on June 15 & 16, 2013 at The Hanover Country Club located in Ashland, Virginia.


